Basic Components:

Private half hour lessons once per week Strings open to students in grades K-8, Band open to students in grades 1-8.

Band Registration and Tuition Payment:

**Registration Fee:** \$25 annual fee. Enrollment is on a yearly basis (Sept. – May) Lesson Tuition: \$810 annual tuition. Monthly Payment Plan = 90/mo. (Sept. – May) Payment Policy: Monthly fees are due to the office by the first of the month. If student withdraws, charges are pro-rated on a trimester basis. Payment is not required for the entire year, but is required for the entire trimester in which the child has attended lessons. Withdrawal must be made in writing and is effective at the end of the trimester. Make checks payable to FCS.

#### Instrument Use Agreement

Instrument Loaner Program: \$25 annual maintenance fee (No monthly fee) Available on first come basis.

Band Instruments: Flute, Oboe\*, Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Bassoon\*, Alto/Tenor/Baritone Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn, Baritone, Tuba.

String Instruments: Violin, Viola, Cello\*, Bass\*

Drums/Percussion: Available for in school use only. Students must provide drumsticks. \*Certain instruments not available from the school and must be rented or purchased by student.
