

Curriculum


- Develop a school-wide writing program

- Purchase more science equipment including microscopes

Financial

- Do a feasibility study to determine whether or not to build a high school
- Increase faculty and sta salaries to be more in-line with industry standards
- Build the FCC Scholarship Endowment Fund to \$1 million to provide more tuition scholarships for families with need
- Increase nancial reserves to maintain a position to purchase additional property as it becomes available
- Hire a Director of Development
- Recruit students commensurate with our school philosophy of God-honoring excellence

Renovations at Grand Ave. Campus

- Complete a total campus "makeover" - frontage, courtyard, buildings
- Renovate the Child Care Room
- Completely modernize the kitchen Purchase new furniture for the library
- Update the plumbing throughout the facility
- Remove acoustic ceiling treatments from classrooms
- Upgrade drop ceiling in the Fellowship Hall
- Install central air conditioning system in Room 2

Baseline Improvements

- Benovate the gymnasium bathrooms Resurface the gym oor
- Purchase new tables for JH art classroom Construct exterior windows in 6 th grade wing

Technology

- Have our system evaluated by a consultant to determine best platform and performance to support the instructional program
- Increase the computer lab time for children Improve the students basic typing and word processing skills
- Develop a more interactive website as a key source of information for parents including homework, grades, and special activities, etc.
- Plan nancially for the systematic upgrade of all computers
- Hire a Technology Support Person
- Connect all classroom TV's to facilitate central broadcasting for announcements and common learning activities
- Purchase "Smart Boards" for computer labs and science & history classrooms
